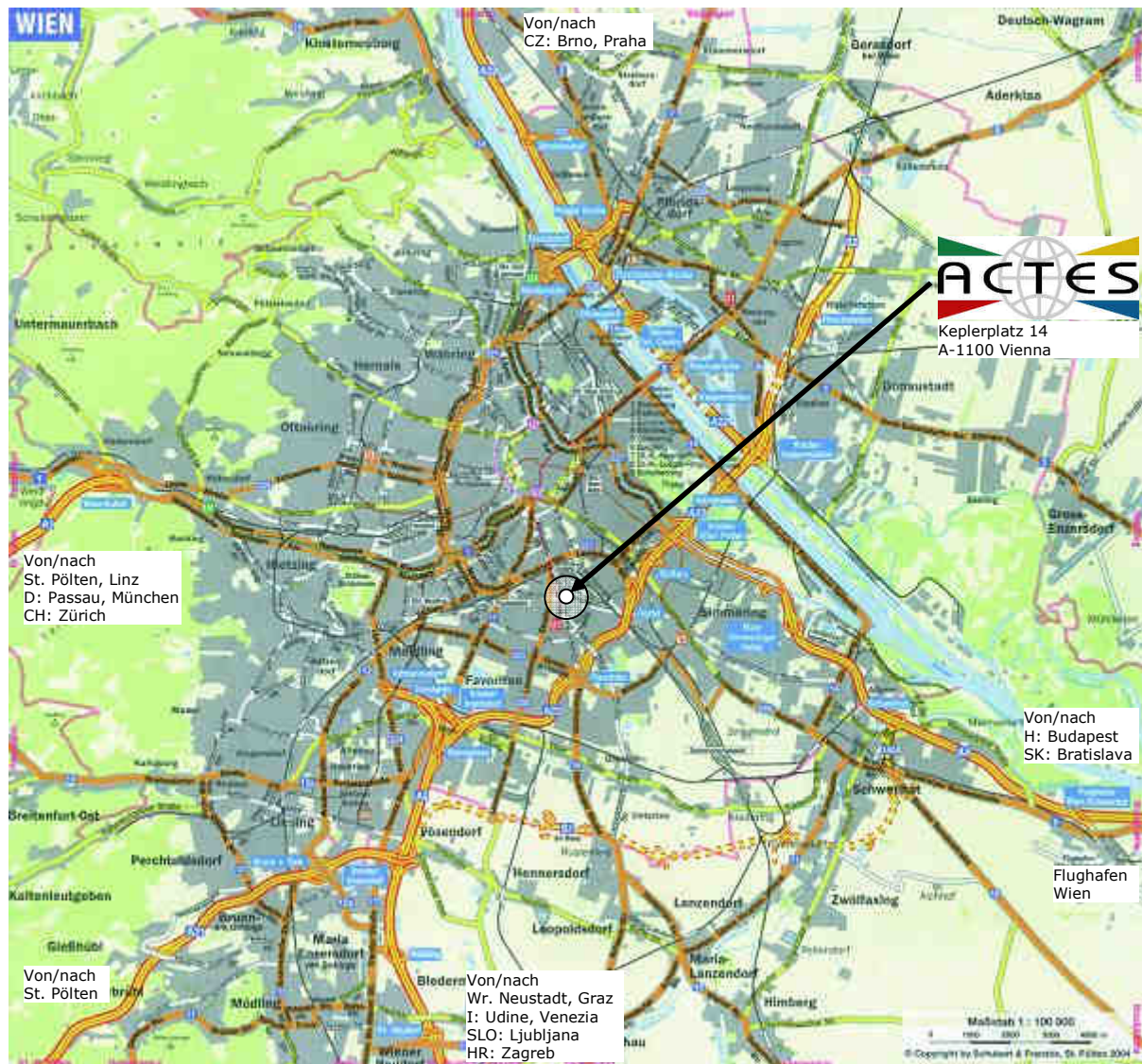


Routing information:

Arriving by car:



a) Coming from the West:

Follow the motorway A1 until its end at Auhof and then go ahead towards Vienna City/Centre (you will pass the Schloss Schönbrunn). As you hit the second ring road (called "Gürtel") turn right and follow the ring road until exit Südtirolerplatz. There turn right into the Laxenburger Strasse (directing you outwards of the city) and after approx. 300 m you have a public car park at the left (Columbusplatz). From there it is approx. 450 m walking along the pedestrian zone of Favoritenstrasse to the office building of **ACTES**. For further information see the detailed description.

b) Coming from the South:

Follow the motorway A2 and then straight ahead motorway A23 (called "Südosttangente") until exit "Favoriten". You have to pass a big roundabout and you should take the 5th exit to the right. Follow the Grenzackerstrasse until you hit the Laxenburger Strasse and turn right in

direction to city centre. After approx. 2 km you have a public car park at the right (Columbusplatz). From there it is approx. 450 m walking along the pedestrian zone of Favoritenstrasse to the office building of **ACTES**. For further information see the detailed description.

c) Coming from the North:

Coming from north-west or directly from north you have to enter the motorway A22 and follow it in the direction Graz/Budapest. Before you will cross the river Danube motorway A22 turns into motorway A23, direction again Graz/Budapest. Go along motorway A23 until exit "Favoriten". You have to pass a big roundabout and you should take the 2nd exit to the right. Follow the Grenzackerstrasse until you hit the Laxenburger Strasse and turn right in direction to city centre. After approx. 2 km you have a public car park at the right (Columbusplatz). From there it is approx. 450 m walking along the pedestrian zone of Favoritenstrasse to the office building of **ACTES**. For further information see the detailed description.

d) Coming from the East:

You will arrive via motorway A4, passing the Vienna Airport at Schwechat. Follow motorway A4 until the intersection with motorway A23 at Knoten Wien Prater. There you have to change to motorway A23 in direction Graz. Go along motorway A23 until exit "Favoriten". You have to pass a big roundabout and you should take the 2nd exit to the right. Follow the Grenzackerstrasse until you hit the Laxenburger Strasse and turn right in direction to city centre. After approx. 2 km you have a public car park at the right (Columbusplatz). From there it is approx. 450 m walking along the pedestrian zone of Favoritenstrasse to the office building of **ACTES**. For further information see the detailed description.

Arriving by aircraft:

From the Vienna Airport you can take a taxi (fee is approx. from 30 to 50 Euro) or you can take a train (Suburban Train (fee is approx. 4 Euro) or City-Airport-Train (CAT – fee is approx. 11 Euro)) from Vienna Airport to Railway Station Wien-Mitte. There you have to change to underground line no. 3 (U3) in the direction to Ottakring until you reach station Stephansplatz (City). There you have to change to underground line no. 1 (U1) in the direction to Reumannplatz until you reach station Keplerplatz. If you take the exit named Keplerplatz from the platform you will exit directly in front of the office building of **ACTES**.

Going by public transport:

The office building of **ACTES** is situated closely to the underground line no. 1 (U1) at the Keplerplatz station. With underground line no. 1 (U1) you will have all connections to other underground lines, the suburban train lines or the tramway and bus system of Vienna. Please remember to get your ticket for public transport before you start!



Observing the above plan of Vienna's public transport system you will easily find your way to **ACTES** from Western Train Station ("Westbahnhof"), Main Train Station ("Hauptbahnhof") and the two Northern Train Stations ("Kaiser Franz Josefs Bahnhof" and "Bahnhof Wien Nord - Praterstern") or from any other location within Vienna.
